## Interurban Trail Construction

As early as June 20, Sound Transit's contractor will be working at the Interurban Trail near 44<sup>th</sup> Ave W to complete stream construction. Work will be conducted at night from June 20 – June 24, from 7 PM – 3 AM, and there will be flaggers to direct bike and pedestrian traffic. Work will be conducted during the day from June 27 – July 1, during which there may be brief flagging operations across the trail to transport equipment. Please see the map for the construction zone.

### What

Construction activity on the Interurban Trail that may disrupt pedestrian traffic.

### When

Evening work will take place June 20-24, 7 PM – 3 AM. Daytime work will take place June 27- July 1, during normal business hours. Flaggers will be on site to safely escort pedestrians and bikers

### Where

Interurban trail between 46<sup>th</sup> Ave W and 44<sup>th</sup> Ave W (see map)

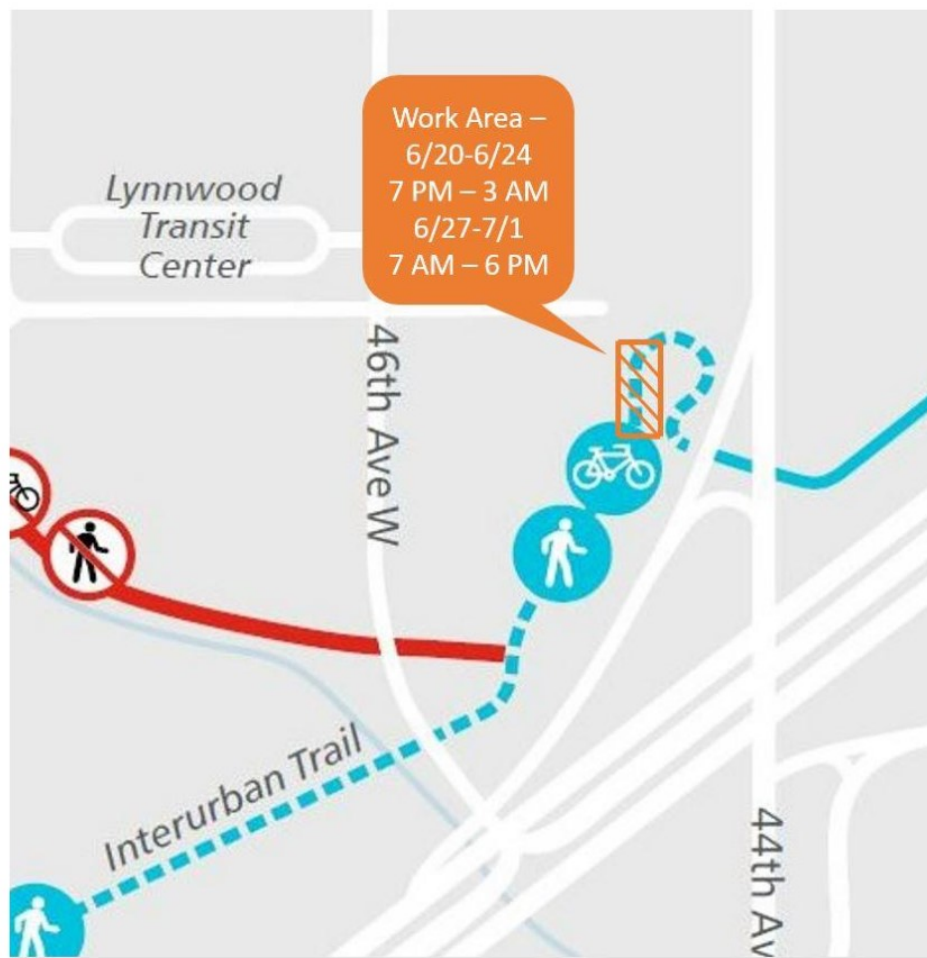
